We work 10 hour days in all types of weather, terrain, and thick brush. You will be carrying your own daypack with lunch, water, raingear, first aid kit, and a belt with tools and herbicide bottles. Your pack would weigh around 50 lbs. For treating weeds with herbicides, you must wear long pants, long sleeves, hiking boots and socks, and gloves. We'll be killing weeds in the forest almost every day, in very strenuous conditions.

Have you done much hiking before?

Do you have any physical conditions which might inhibit your ability to endure strenuous activity?

Are you ok with using herbicides regularly?

Do you have allergies?

We have group housing and everyone is responsible for cleaning up after themselves and also general deep cleaning on your own time. It's a large building (25' X 80') and all personal things must be kept in one's room. All public areas must be kept clean and organized at all times. Food must be kept in containers and no dirty dishes are allowed to be left in the sink.

Are you neat and tidy in your personal living?

How do you feel about extra work-for example, watering our nursery on the weekends?

Please ensure you read carefully the waiver form that you need to sign. Are you ok with the potential dangers/risks listed?

The housing is rustic and very basic. For example, the electricity is often unreliable. Are you ok with the rustic living conditions?

You may be sharing the bunkhouse with other volunteers/interns or you might be by yourself. The site is very remote (15 miles from the nearest town or beach), transportation isn't always available unless you rent a car, and cell phones often do not work.

Are you open to learning even though it may be different from what you may have already been taught?
